Approving of Award of Contract for the REBIDDING OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR APRIL TO DECEMBER 2025

WHEREAS, Open Competitive Bidding for the REBIDDING OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR APRIL TO DECEMBER 2025 was conducted in accordance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid (IB) was posted in PhilGEPS dated 12 February 2025, and in a conspicuous place at the premises of MARIVELES MENTAL WELLNESS AND GENERAL HOSPITAL compound;

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bid Conference was held on 20 February 2025, at 09:00 AM at the Procurement Conference Room and/or through webcasting via Zoom, Mariveles Mental Wellness and General Hospital – Mariveles, Bataan with six (6) prospective bidders attending, namely:

2. Karpa II Security Services
3. Lauderez Security and Investigation Services
4. Militant Security Services

6. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc.

WHEREAS, two (2) bidders procured the bidding documents, namely:

2. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc.

WHEREAS, on the scheduled Submission and Opening of Bids last 04 March, 2025, 09:00 AM, at the Mariveles Mental Wellness and General Hospital Compound– Mariveles Bataan, two (2) bidders tendered their Bid;

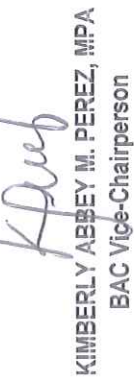
