Approving the Award of the Contract for Item Nos. 1,2, 3, 5-7,9-11, 13-14, 17-18, 21-27, 29-30, 33-39, 41-43, 45-46 and Declaring Failure for Item Nos. 4, 8, 12, 15, 16, 19, 20, 28, 31, 32, 40 & 44 for the Procurement of Medical Supplies for SVP – Other Medical Supplies

WHEREAS, the Laboratory Unit, Male Ward Unit (MLW), OR & DR Complex Unit (ODR), and OPU Medical Unit (OPM) intends to procure Various Medical Supplies under Purchase Request No. 2024-11-0756, 2024-11-0856, 2024-11-0879 and 2024-11-0855 dated November 05 to November 11, 2025 with an Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) ₱846,000.00 charged to General Appropriations Act (GAA) as per Various Unit's Approved Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) 2025 & Work and Financial Plan (WFP) 2025;

WHEREAS, through BAC Resolution 2025-025 under Competitive Bidding for the Procurement of Medical Supplies and Devices 2025 (EPA) Bidding Project 2024-34 with Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations, the Bids and Awards Committee Declared Failure for the cited items due to NO BID and resolved to conduct a rebidding upon submission of Revised Purchase Request, Certificate of Availability of Funds (CAF) or Letter of Request received by Budget and Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP);

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2025, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) received a letter from the end user **requesting for the cited Medical Supplies / items to be procured through Small Value Procurement to hasten the procurement process, to meet the demands and to augment the diminishing stocks;**

WHEREAS, under BAC Resolution No 2025-172A dated April 03, 2025 the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) recommended the use of Small Value as the mode of Procurement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Item No. IV.E.3 of Annex "H" of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, a Purchase Request was posted in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website for six (6) consecutive days, starting on April 05, 2025 to April 10, 2025, a Request for Quotation (RFQ) dated April 04, 2025 was sent to the following qualified suppliers with a deadline on April 10, 2025;

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2025, the Bids and Awards Committee convened and conducted an opening of sealed canvass and in response to the posting and request for quotation, FIVE (5) suppliers submitted their bid on April 10, 2025, as follows;

WHEREAS, upon the evaluation of the submitted Request for Quotation (RFQ), it was found that the bid offer of the respective Lowest Calculated Bidders (LCB) for the following item Nos. was substantially complying - Item Nos. 1,2, 3, 5-7,9-11, 13-14, 17-18, 21-27, 29, 33-39, 41-43, 46;

WHEREAS, upon the evaluation of the submitted Request for Quotation (RFQ), it was found that the bid offer of the respective Lowest Calculated Bidders (LCB) for the following item Nos. was technically non-compliant – Item Nos. 30 & 45;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation of the Submitted Request for Quotation (RFQ) for item Nos. 30 & 45, it was found out that the bid offer of the Second Lowest Bidder was technically compliant;

WHEREAS, upon the evaluation of the submitted Request for Quotation (RFQ), it was found that there's NO BID offer for the following Item Nos. 4, 8, 12,15,16,19,20,28,31, 40 & 44;

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WHEREAS, on May 29, 2025, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) received a letter from the end user, Laboratory Unit requesting to decrease the quantity of the cited Medical Supplies **item No. 32 Reagent, Oral Glucose Solution, 75grams from 1,500 bottles to 300 bottles;**

WHEREAS, due to the changes in quantity during the procurement process the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) recommended to invoke Section 41. Reservation Clause of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184:

Sec 41. Reservation Clause – *The Head of the Agency reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, declare failure of bidding, or not award the contract in the following situations:*

(C) *For any justifiable and reasonable ground where the award of the contract will not redound to the benefit of the GoP, as follows: (i) if the physical and economic conditions have significantly changed so as to render the project no longer economically, financially, or technically feasible, as determined by the HoPE.*

NOW THEREFORE, based on the above, the herein members of the **BAC HEREBY RESOLVE** to **RECOMMEND** the following;

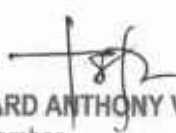
1. TO AWARD Items No. 1,2,5,9,13,22-24, 29, 34, 43, 46 to **AUCSAP MEDICAL SOLUTION** for being determined as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bidder (LCRB) and item nos. 14 & 18 for being determined as the Single Calculated Bidder (SCRB) with a Total Contract Amount of ₱100,999.98, One Hundred Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Pesos And 98/100 Only.
2. TO AWARD Items No. 6 & 7 to **MRL CYBERTEC CORPORATION** for being determined as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bidder (LCRB) and Items No. 25-27, 33 & 35 for being determined as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder (SCRB) with a Total Contract Amount of ₱40,724.00, Forty Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Pesos Only.
3. TO AWARD Item No. 42 to **MUREX DIAGNOSTIC PRODUCTS SPECIALISTS** for being determined as the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bidder (LCRB) with a Total Contract Amount of ₱5,500.00, Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos Only.

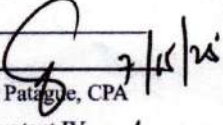
