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### Approving of Award of Contract for the Provision of Security Services for 2026 (EPA)

**WHEREAS**, Open Competitive Bidding for 2025-38 Provision of Security Services for 2026 (EPA) was conducted in accordance with the Republic Act 12009 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;

**WHEREAS**, the Invitation to Bid (ITB) was posted on PhilGEPS on November 28, 2025, on the agency's official website and in a conspicuous place within the premises of the MARIVELES MENTAL WELLNESS AND GENERAL HOSPITAL compound, specifically at the Procurement Office Building and Administrative Office Building Bulletin Board;

**WHEREAS**, a Pre-Bid Conference was held on December 10, 2025 at 9:00 AM at the Procurement Conference Room and/or through webcasting via Zoom, Mariveles Mental Wellness and General Hospital – Mariveles, Bataan, FOUR (4) prospective bidders attending namely;

1. Gaddi Force Security & Investigation Agency, Inc.
2. Karpa II Security Services
3. Militant Security Services
4. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, THREE (3) bidders procured the bidding documents, namely;

1. Karpa II Security Services
2. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc.
3. Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, on the scheduled Submission and Opening of Bids held on December 22, 2025, at 9:00 AM, at the Mariveles Mental Wellness and General Hospital Compound – Mariveles, Bataan, THREE (3) bidders tendered their bids, namely:

1. Karpa II Security Services
2. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc.
3. Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc.

**WHEREAS**, the original envelopes containing the Eligibility and Technical Documents were opened. The presence, completeness, and correctness of the required documents were checked and verified by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) in the presence of the bidders. The results are as follows:

1. Karpa II Security Services - eligible
2. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc. - eligible
3. Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc. - eligible

**WHEREAS**, the Financial Proposal of the eligible bidders were opened. The presence, completeness, and correctness of the document were checked and verified by the BAC. The results are as follows:

1. Karpa II Security Services - eligible
2. St. Moritz Security Agency, Inc. - eligible
3. Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc. - eligible



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**WHEREAS**, the bidders who were declared “Eligible” and was rated “PASSED” and subsequently their respective bids were publicly read and posted in the Abstract of Bids, to wit;

**WHEREAS**, a Bid Evaluation was conducted on December 23, 2025, however, the Technical Working Group noted inconsistencies in the computation of financial bids, thus, a detailed bid evaluation was conducted until December 26, 2026, reflecting the following summary of bids;

**WHEREAS**, on January 5, 2026, the BAC, together with the TWG proceeded with the post-qualification of the documents submitted by the Lowest Calculated Bidder, Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc.;

**WHEREAS**, during post-qualification, it was determined that the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) Platinum Certificate of Registration of the said bidder was valid only until December 31, 2025, and had already expired at the time of post-qualification;

**WHEREAS**, on the same day, the BAC, through its Secretariat, formally requested in writing the submission of an updated PhilGEPS Platinum Certificate of Registration from the said bidder; however, the bidder submitted only a proof of payment for the renewal of the said certificate;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the foregoing, the BAC granted the said bidder an opportunity to submit its renewed PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration; accordingly, on January 6, 2026, the BAC, through its Secretariat, formally notified Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc. in writing thereof, with a deadline of January 9, 2026;

**WHEREAS**, on the prescribed deadline, Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc. submitted a copy of the acknowledgment issued by the PhilGEPS as proof of the successful submission of its Platinum Membership application, which was further supported by a notarized affidavit executed by Mr. Diosdado S. Labarentos, President of the said agency, stating that the PhilGEPS Platinum Membership shall be issued to the agency within seven (7) days upon receipt of its payment;

**WHEREAS**, considering the timeline for the issuance of the renewed PhilGEPS Platinum Membership Certificate, and taking into account the circumstances stated in the notarized affidavit, the BAC granted the said agency until 14 January 2026 at 5:00 P.M. to submit a scanned copy of the Certified True Copy (CTC) of its renewed PhilGEPS Platinum Membership Certificate;

**WHEREAS**, within the period prescribed by the BAC, Saint Nicolas Security Agency, Inc. duly submitted the aforementioned required document;

**NOW THEREFORE**, We, the members of the BAC, hereby RESOLVE as it is RESOLVED to recommend the Provision of Security Services for 2026 (EPA) to be awarded to **SAINT NICOLAS SECURITY AGENCY, INC.** which was determined as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid with contract amounting to Php 10,141,711.78 Ten Million One Hundred Forty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Eleven Pesos and 78/100 Only.
